



Do you need a buyer or a supplier ticket for the annual RE-Source event?

The corporate PPA market has accelerated in Europe and is fast innovating. The typical buyer-supplier distinction is less clear-cut with the rise of renewable hydrogen and e-fuels. Therefore, this year, we have updated the ticket definitions of what we consider a buyer and supplier.

- **Renewable Energy Buyers:** corporate or public sector buyers looking to procure renewable energy for electricity consumption directly on their sites, where their main activity is the production of non-energy goods or services
- **Suppliers:** Suppliers of renewable electricity or hydrogen; suppliers of services for renewable energy buyers; attendees from other sectors who are not renewable energy buyers

RE-Source's core mission remains to grow the pool of corporate energy buyers in Europe. The Hosted Buyers Programme was established with the goal of helping non-energy experts to take their first steps in renewable energy procurement. Whilst RE-Source also caters to experienced buyers and reflects this in the event offering, we developed the Hosted Buyers Programme to provide basic information to people who are relatively new renewables procurement who are motivated to decarbonise their own companies and products.

A few examples of what we accept as a **Renewable Energy Buyer**:

- You are a food producer looking to sign a PPA to run your food production unit.
- You are a retailer looking to meeting a supplier for rooftop solar for your chain of stores.
- You are a steel producer looking for green electricity in order to produce renewable hydrogen on-site to make steel.

A few examples of what we accept as a **supplier**:

- You are an energy developer or utility – regardless of your department in the company.
- You provide software to energy buyers to help them optimise their energy procurement.
- You are a trader.
- Your main business is producing hydrogen or e-fuels and supplying it to final users, such as producers of cement or steel.
- You are a consultant, lawyer, or other 3rd party involved in PPA negotiations.
